

NOTICE OF MEETING

FORT BEND COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 155

The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 155 will hold a regular meeting on **Thursday, September 10, 2026, at 3:30 p.m.**, at Bonbrook Plantation Recreational Center, 9210 Reading Road, Rosenberg, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Public comments.
2. Security matters, including:
 - a. renewal of Law Enforcement Service Contract with Fort Bend County; and
 - b. Fort Bend Constable's report.
3. Approve minutes.
4. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of bills and review of investments, if appropriate.
5. Operation of District, including:
 - a. water, sanitary sewer, and drainage facilities, billings, repairs and maintenance, irrigation meter usage, utility surveying, and meter replacements; and
 - b. hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service.
6. Engineering matters, including approval of any pay estimates, change orders, design, plan and specification authorizations, advertisement of bids, award of contracts, letter financing agreements, and maintenance agreements, including:
 - a. Benton Road Commercial Site;
 - b. update on joint facilities;
 - c. deeds, easements, plants, and consent to encroachments;
 - d. capital improvement plan;
 - e. update on Bond Application No. 10; and
 - f. other engineering matters.
7. Update on detention/amenity lakes maintenance.
8. Phase II Small MS4 General Permit and Storm Water Management Plan, and authorize appropriate action.
9. Update on landscape maintenance and irrigation from GreenScape Associates, including:
 - a. District park and recreation improvements, including authorize design, approve plans and specifications, authorize advertisement for bids, review bids and award contracts, approve pay estimates and change orders, authorize final acceptance of projects, and direct landscape architect to notify insurance company of acceptance of projects;

- b. proposals for maintenance and repairs; and
 - c. update on detention/amenity lakes maintenance.
- 10. District communications, including website, mass messaging, social media policies, and authorize appropriate action.
 - 11. Garbage and recycling matters.
 - 12. Tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills.
 - 13. Conduct public hearing regarding District's tax rate, adopt Order Levying Taxes and authorize execution of Amendment to Information Form.
 - 14. Annual report to Bond Review Board.
